Host a Diaper Drive for WestSide Baby!

Did you know...?

- A newborn needs up to 14 diapers/day
- One child's supply of diapers averages \$100/month
- 1 in 3 families struggle to afford diapers
- Food Stamps do not cover diapers
- Struggling parents need to work but most daycares require disposable diapers
- Using cloth diapers takes skill, soap, money and time – challenges for many facing poverty
- Most laundromats will not allow diaper washing
- Providing something as simple as diapers allows parents to pay other bills and work toward becoming self-sufficient

These facts create a "diaper dilemma" for many low-income families. Host a diaper drive now to make a difference in the lives of 37,885 children.

Step 1: Sign Up!

Step 2: Set a Goal

Let us know how many diapers you think you can collect. 500, 1,000, 15,000?

Step 3: Decide When and Where

Diaper drives can be a one-time event or last over a period of time, from one week to a month. Hold one at your work, school, church or in your home. Include a drive as part of an event or celebration at your BBQ or birthday party.

Step 4: Promote Your Diaper Drive

Spread the word and let people know you need help to reach your goal. Shout it out via email and social media. Start an Amazon wish list, we can show you how.

Step 5: Collect Donations: Diapers, Wipes and/or Cash

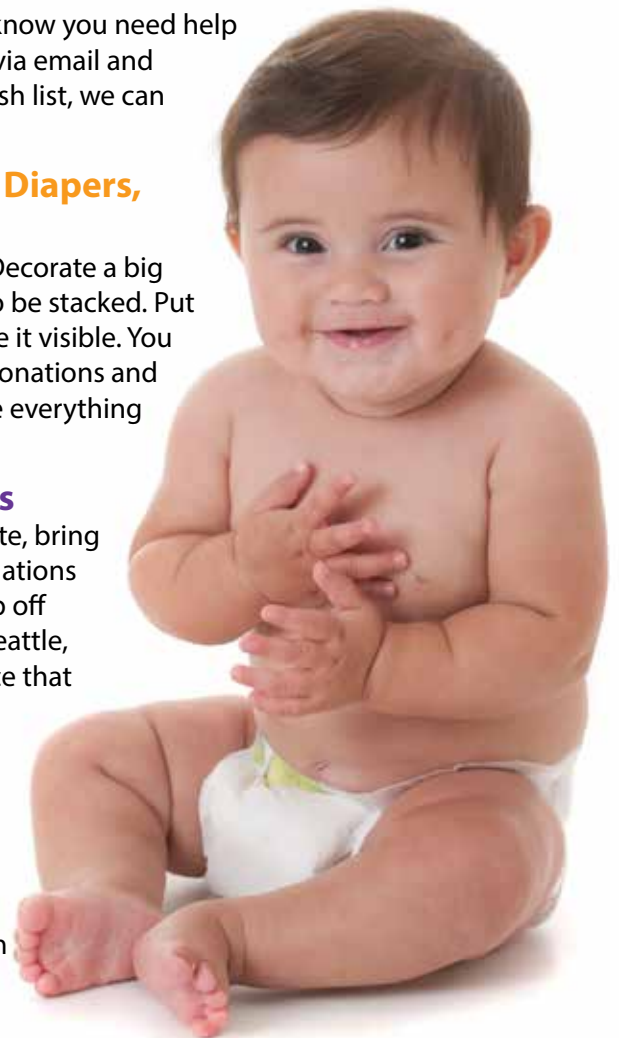
You can host a drive anywhere. Decorate a big box or clear a space for diapers to be stacked. Put up the posters we give you. Make it visible. You can put out a jar to collect cash donations and we'll do the shopping. Make sure everything is secure!

Step 6: Drop Off Donations

Once your diaper drive is complete, bring collected items and any cash donations to WestSide Baby's donation drop off location at 10002 14th Ave SW, Seattle, WA 98146. Let us know in advance that you're coming so we can roll out the red carpet.

Step 7: Celebrate!

Celebrate your success and be sure to thank everyone who helped! Together we're keeping kids in our community safe, warm and dry.



CREATIVE TIPS FOR YOUR DIAPER DRIVE:

INCREASE THE SUCCESS OF YOUR DIAPER DRIVE

Here are some ideas to get your diaper drive off to a great start. Feel free to come up with your own creative methods!

- Students vs. teachers competition at your school.
- Girls Night Out at your house – Bring diapers instead of hostess gifts or diapers AND wine.
- Children's birthdays – Collect diapers to donate instead of collecting gifts.
- Summer BBQ – Provide burgers and gather diapers.
- Dads for diapers – Set up a baby changing competition.
- Baby showers (especially for Baby #2) – When parents have it all already, honor them and collect to donate in celebration of their new baby.
- On-line diaper drive – Spread the word and ask donors to give through our Amazon.com wish list.
- Create a business incentive – Bring in diapers and receive a discount or free latte.
- Scavenger hunt – Have one stop on the hunt be purchasing a package of diapers.
- Add diapers to anything – Just about any gathering is a place for diaper collection. Diapers are a great "entrance fee."
- Any time a group of 2+ people get together is a time for diaper collecting!
