The 2020 JOY Campaign

Each year, we see an increased need during November and December as the weather gets colder and families on a limited income stretch their dollars to keep their children warm.

We depend on you, as a member of our WestSide Baby family, to [host donation drives](#) - or “JOY drives”, and to engage your family, coworkers, friends and neighbors in collecting our most needed items this winter!

What is “JOY” ?

- Through November and December, we encourage our community to host drives to gather new items from our “most needed” list.
- We also depend greatly on financial gifts during this end of year time. Please consider making a secure gift online at westsidebaby.org/donate-now
- We will provide support for you during your drive, as well as materials such as posters, collection boxes and [social media graphics](#) you can share with your communities. We will be emailing you and updating our website throughout the campaign.

Why?

- 21% of children in King County lived in families that found it difficult to afford diapers since the child was born
- Almost 20,000 children under the age of five in King County are living in poverty; more than half (10,430) are known to be living in “deep poverty” with incomes less than 50% of the federal poverty level which is currently \$24,600 for a family of four
- Families are impacted by race: 45% of Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander children experience diaper need, 36% of Black children experience diaper need, and 34% of Latino children experience diaper need, while only 14% of White children experience diaper need, well below the King County average.

We will be open for late deliveries January 4 through January 13, 2021.

At this time, we are unable to accept donations of used items, but are accepting donations of new items. During the months of November and December, we request your help in collecting specific items we need most right now. Thank you for including this list as you promote your drive:

- NEW Car seats (especially all-in-one or combination/convertible car seats)
- NEW Booster Car Seats
- NEW pack n plays
- Unopened Packages/ Boxes of Diapers (most needed sizes are 5 &6)
- Unopened Packages/ Boxes of Pull Ups (most needed size is 4T-5T)
- Baby Wipes
- Baby/ Kid Shampoo
- Winter Coats (Especially Infant-- NB-12 months)
- Winter Hats (All sizes)
- Gloves/ Mittens (All sizes)

Mission Statement

WestSide Baby, in partnership with our community, provides essential items for local children in need by collecting and distributing diapers, clothing, and equipment.

Diapers

- WestSide Baby is a diaper bank and a member of the National Diaper Bank Network.
- In 2019 we distributed 1.54 million diapers.
- Did you know you cannot buy diapers with WIC or other public funding? A new study reported that 1 of 3 parents in the U.S. experience diaper need and feel anxious about having enough diapers for their baby. A newborn typically needs 10-14 diapers a day – at least \$100 a month!
- At this time, we can only accept *unopened packages* of diapers.

In addition to hosting and donating to a JOY drive you can support WestSide Baby by...
